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Dear Families,

The Duxbury Public School Department receives Federal funding under Title I Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act. Title I funding provides financial assistance to districts and schools to help ensure that all children meet challenging state academic standards. The Federal funds that individual school districts receive are allocated through four statutory formulas based primarily on census poverty estimates and the cost of education in each state.

The priorities of Title I are to:

1. Strengthen the core program in schools and provide academic and/or support services to at-risk students;
2. Provide evidence-based programs that enable participating students to achieve the learning standards of the state curriculum frameworks;
3. Elevate the quality of instruction by providing eligible staff with substantial opportunities for professional development; and,
4. Involve parents/guardians of participating public and private school children as active partners in their children's education at school through open, meaningful communication, training, and, as appropriate, inclusion in decision-making processes.

Chandler and Alden Elementary Schools are designated as our Title I Targeted Assistance schools. Targeted Assistance refers to the process of providing supplemental services to students who have been determined to be at risk of low achievement. Students receiving Title I support may work in small groups with interventionists in their classroom or outside of their classroom, or students may participate in targeted intervention programs in their classroom setting under the direction of their classroom teacher.
