DPS Computing Device Protection Plan Grades K-12

Duxbury Public Schools envisions and supports an environment where technology is integrated throughout the curriculum to facilitate student-centered, engaging, collaborative, project-based learning. We are providing students in grades K-12 with computing devices to help us achieve this vision during the 2020-2021 school year.

All parents of students grades K-12 are highly encouraged to obtain the DPS Student Chromebook Protection Plan for their child's school-issued Chromebook grades 5-12, MacBook Air grades 2-4 and iPads grades K-2. If you decline to purchase the plan, you are responsible for damage beyond reasonable wear and tear as outlined in the loan agreement. The cost of the plan is \$35.00 for the 2020-2021 school year. The plan covers unlimited claims with no deductible. Malicious and/or intentional damage is not covered by the plan.

DPS Computing Device Protection Plan FAQs

Q. What kinds of accidental damage are covered by the plan?

- A. *It covers drops, spills, theft, fire, power surge damage, natural disasters. The policy includes unlimited claims and no deductibles.*

Q. If we opt not to purchase the plan, what are the ramifications if my child's computing device is damaged?

- A. *The student/parent is responsible for the material costs incurred by accidental damage.*

Q. Will my child be given a loaner computer device if his/her primary device is damaged and needs repairs?

- A. *We provide loaner devices to students while their device is being repaired. If the loaner is damaged while being used by the student and the student does not have the optional protection plan coverage, the student will also be responsible for the cost of loaner device damages.*

Q. If a student device needs to be replaced, will the Computing Device Protection Plan coverage automatically be rolled over to the new device or do we need to sign up for a new policy?

- A. *The policy will automatically be applied to the replacement device.*
