

## **SCHOOL-COMMUNITY RELATIONS GOALS**

The Duxbury School Committee believes that education can be improved to result in increased instructional benefits for students by establishment of a program of communications. This belief includes the following principles:

1. The program should be a planned, systematic, two-way process of communication between the schools and the parents and other town residents.
2. The program should be many-faceted and should include a variety of media to efficiently and effectively inform all citizens.
3. Communications, to be effective, must include a planned program with involvement and feedback, including opinion questionnaires and public forums.
4. Communications must be internal as well as external and must stress the dissemination of factual, objective, and realistic data about the schools.
5. Communication must be dynamic and sensitive to change as determined by events and evaluation of the program.
