PSAT 2022**

This year Duxbury High School will offer the PSAT on Saturday, October 15, 2022. Registration will be conducted through Duxbury High School Guidance. We only have room for a limited number of students but juniors and sophomores are encouraged to register. There is a **deadline of Monday, September 19th** for students to submit the registration form and payment to the Guidance Office, students will be registered on a first come first serve basis. The cost of the exam is \$40. Payment may be made in the form of cash or check made out to Duxbury High School.

PSAT Fast Facts:

When: Saturday, October 15, 2022 at 8 am (the test starts at 8am so students should report to the high school by 7:45am)
Please note that this is the only test date Duxbury High School will offer for the PSAT, which is tested nationally on this date.

PSAT Overview

The PSAT/NMSQT measures reading, writing and language, and math skills developed over many years, both in and out of school in three test sections: Reading, Writing and Language, and Math. There are 2 hours and 45 minutes of actual testing time. Time for short breaks and test administration tasks is additional. The test time is 165 minutes but additional time is needed for registration and breaks. Most students in the standard time rooms will be here from 8am until 12:30pm. Rooms move at different paces so times are only approximate.
