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## SCHOOL RULES

**All rules that pertain to the regular school year will apply to summer school.**

- The Whitman-Hanson Regional School District is committed to providing a safe environment. According to public health experts, one of the best ways to stop the spread of coronavirus and to keep members of our school community safe is the use of face masks or face coverings. Therefore, in accordance with guidance from the Center for Disease Control (CDC), the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) and the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (DPH), **face coverings must be worn at all times while on school grounds.**
- Whitman-Hanson is a smoke and drug-free environment, both inside the building and on the grounds.
- Students referred to the Summer School Coordinator for disruptive behavior in class can be withdrawn from class **and** forfeit payment.
- Parents and students should be aware that serious violations will result in immediate expulsion from summer school **and** forfeit of payment.

### ATTENDANCE:

*Due to the concentrated nature of summer school classes, it is imperative that students are on time for their scheduled session(s) and in attendance **each day**. Due to the fact that extenuating circumstances arise, please call or email Ms. Asci if your child will be absent, tardy or need to be dismissed. Students who are absent, tardy or dismissed will need to schedule a make-up session with Ms. Asci. Failure to attend **and** make-up missed sessions **will result in expulsion** from the summer school program and a **forfeit of payment**. Students taking online courses must successfully complete 25% of their course(s) in order to be considered in attendance each week. **\*Please Note: Students taking online courses are required to take all Pre and Post Assessments on-site with a trained instructor.***

### GRADES:

*On a weekly basis, parents will be notified of their child's progress in his/her course(s). Parents of students taking online courses will be notified each week if their child **did not** make the 25% completion goal. Upon successful completion of summer school course work, a grade report will be mailed to the address given on the registration form. Ms. Asci will also contact school counselors to inform them of your child's grade(s).*

### STUDENT REGULATIONS AND BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS:

*All regulations for student conduct that pertain to the school year will also apply to the Summer School program. The following should be noted, because they constitute grounds for expulsion from summer school:*

- Excessive tardiness/absence and failure to make-up class time missed
- Disruption of classes or school
- Smoking anywhere on school grounds
- Fighting, hazing, or harassment
- Use or possession of drugs or alcohol
- Use of electronic devices, including cell phones, during class
- Leaving school without permission
- Loitering or being in an unauthorized area
- Failure to respond to a reasonable request from a staff member
- Use of profanity or vulgarity toward other students or faculty
- Cheating or plagiarism
- Any other disruptive or inappropriate acts judged serious by the Summer School Director or a staff member.
